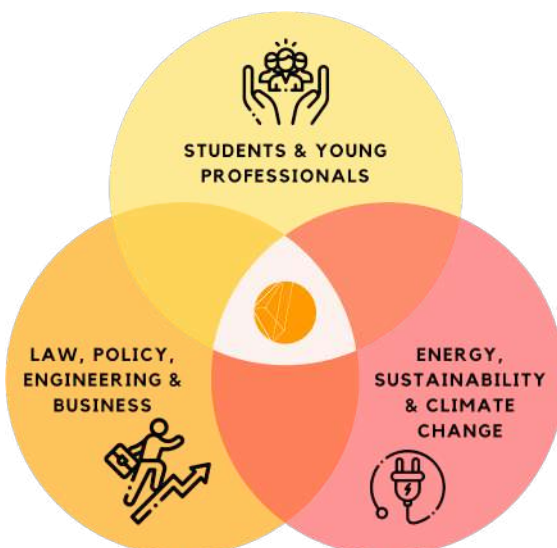

In order to find solutions for the future of the "post COVID-19" more sustainable, in the spring of 2020 we held our first climate hackathon, or "Climathon"! 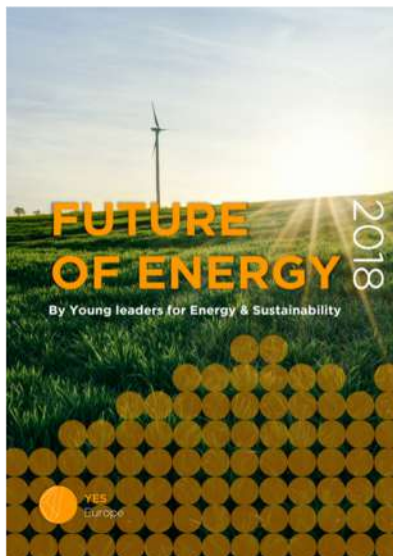

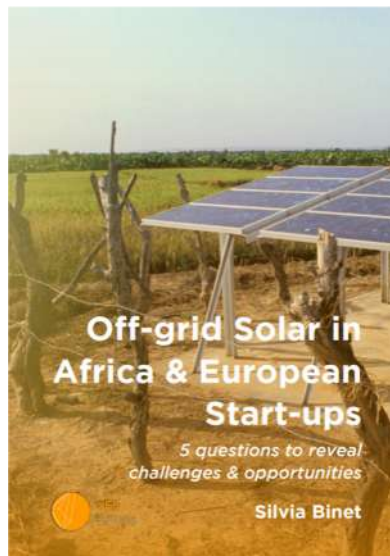

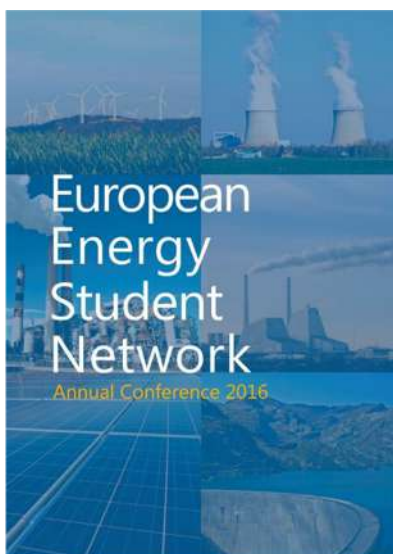
